“On most days the Wildcat Mountain vines stand with their heads in the fog rolling in off the Pacific Ocean. The cool marine climate keeps yields low at Wildcat, and in 2004 MacRostie got less than two tons per acre. From the small, intensive grapes, MacRostie fashioned a sumptuous fruit-forward Pinot, with intense, deep black cherry and spice aromas, rich texture and complex flavors, including black fruits and pepper. It is supple and smooth through the finish.”
